

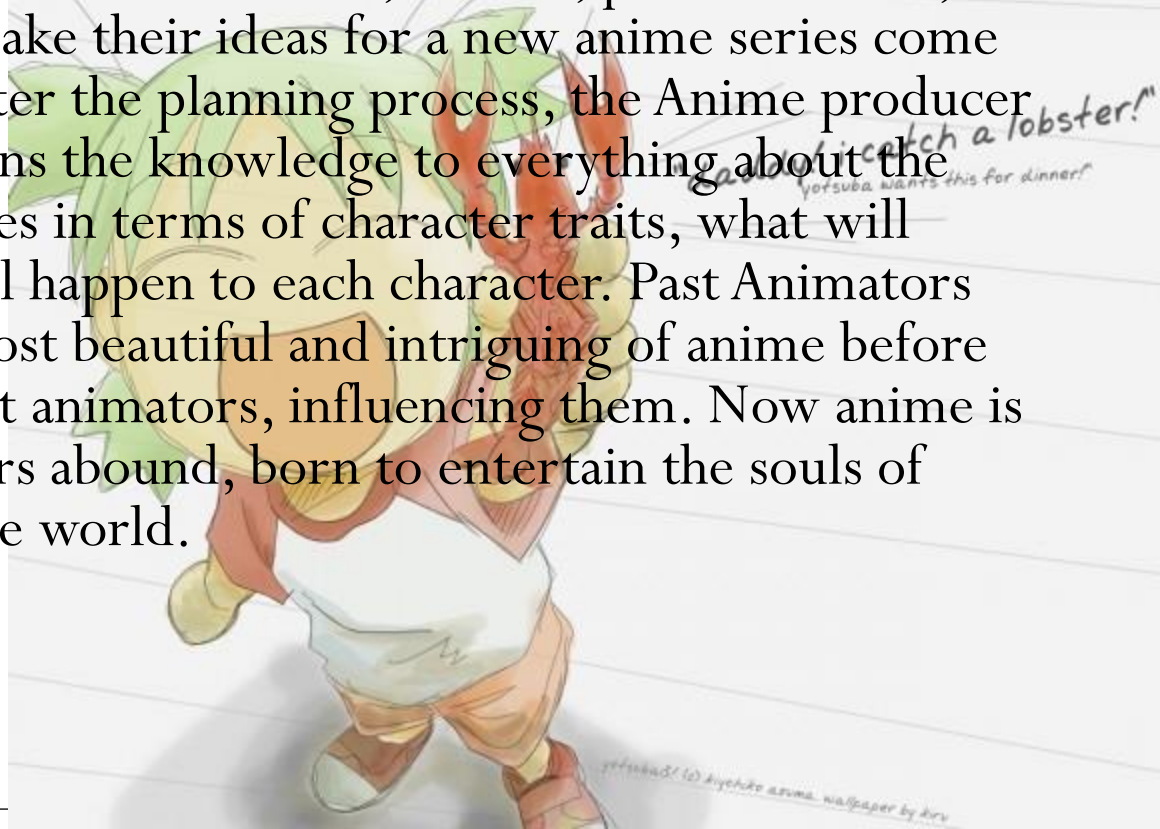

After the planning process, the Anime producer is the one who contains the knowledge to everything about the plot of his or her series in terms of character traits, what will happen, and what will happen to each character.
